Parents and carers will be asked to keep their children at home when they are unwell and to take them for PCR tests if they display a high temperature, new continuous cough or loss of taste or smell. Staff will continue ensure that children are not allowed to come into the setting if they are unwell. Staff and children will continue to follow hygiene measures including hand washing on arrival, before lunch and after playing outside and use of hand sanitiser. Staff will continue to take LFD tests twice weekly to identify any asymptomatic cases early. Appropriate cleaning regimes will continue to be implemented on a daily basis. Where a member of staff is not double vaccinated and is identified as a close contact of someone with Covid-19 they should isolate following government guidelines for the full period. Where double vaccinated members of staff are identified as a close contact the test.
